Outcome: January thru June 2020



HOUSING OUTCOMES

In the first half of 2020 Tracy CCC helped:

- 62 individuals were placed into motels
- 38 individuals find emergency shelter
- 4 individuals received assistance with rent or deposit

SHOWERS (and More!)

In the first 6 months of 2020 Tracy CCC provided:

- 451 showers for 109 individuals (unduplicated) at our Mobile Shower Unit
- 237 Hygiene Products for 106 individuals
- 58 loads of Laundry for 29 individuals



CASE MANAGEMENT



January thru June 2020 Tracy CCC assisted:

- 121 individuals (unduplicated) with 291 services; of these,
- 25 individuals received transportation assistance
- 14 individuals received assistance with their California ID
- 13 individuals received referrals for medical assistance
- 12 individuals received referrals to mental health assistance
- 6 individuals were helped with employment
- 4 individuals were helped with their social security application
- 3 individuals received assistance with their unemployment/disability application
